## Review the FCDL

FCDL	Look For	Next Step
Cover Letter/Funding Status	<ul><li>Approved Funds</li><li>As Yet Unfunded</li><li>Under Review</li><li>Denied</li></ul>	<ul> <li>File FCC Form 486</li> <li>Wait for P2 determination</li> <li>Wait for next FCDL approved/denied</li> <li>Option to appeal USAC's decision</li> </ul>
Service Provider Name & SPIN	<ul> <li>Typo or wrong SPIN</li> <li>Entire company merges or is sold or purchase occurs</li> <li>Part of the company merges or is sold or purchase occurs</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Submit a corrective SPIN change to SL to correct</li> <li>Submit SPIN change to USAC Billing, Collections, and Disbursements (BCD)</li> <li>Submit SPIN change to SL</li> </ul>
Service Start & End Date	Incorrect dates	<ul> <li>Correct on the FCC Form 486</li> <li>If the dates on the FCC Form 486 are incorrect, submit FCC Form 500</li> </ul>



## Review the FCDL

FCDL	Look For	Next Step
Monthly & Annual Charges	<ul> <li>Amount requested decreased</li> <li>Annual charges included in the monthly charges</li> <li>Over-estimate of the cost of the project or project canceled</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Review the FCDL explanation to see which ineligible entities, products, service costs were removed</li> <li>Submit an appeal to correct</li> <li>Submit a FCC Form 500 to reduce the commitment or cancel FRN. Submit FCC Form 486 for remaining amount.</li> </ul>
Contract Expiration	Incorrect date	Submit FCC Form 500 to change date
Billing Account Number	<ul> <li>Incorrect number or add number</li> </ul>	Pre-commitment: RAL correction;     Post-commitment: Submit an appeal to correct
Funding Commitment Decision Explanation	Explanation as to why the FRN was modified or denied	<ul> <li>If modified, the applicant must still file FCC Form 486</li> <li>If modified or denied, you have the option to appeal</li> </ul>



- Applicants file the FCC Form 486
  - Informs USAC services started or will start
  - Filed when FRN is approved
  - Applicant certifies CIPA and TPA compliance
  - Must be filed by 120 days after services start or FCDL date, whichever is later
- Service Providers receive notification letter when FCC Form 486 is certified
  - Can begin invoicing once form is certified



# FCC Form 486 Misconceptions

- Wait to file FCC Form 486 until you receive your appeal decision for a partially approved FRN
   TRUTH - File the FCC Form 486 anytime funding is approved (full or partial)
- You can't file a FCC Form 486 with a State Replacement SPIN
  - **TRUTH** File the FCC Form 486 when you receive the FCDL. Once the service provider is selected, submit a SPIN change. The service start date can be adjusted at that time.



# FRN Changes

Helping Keep Americans Connected

### **SPIN Changes**

SPIN Change Type	Submitter	Action
Global – <u>all</u> of the FRNs, change from old to new service provider	Service Provider	Submit to BCD Approved, E-file notification sent to SP general contact
Corrective – data entry error or change not initiated by applicant	Service Provider or Applicant	Submit to SL Approved, RFCDL sent to applicant & SP
Operational – from old to new service provider. Must submit by last date to invoice.	Applicant	Submit to SL Approved, RFCDL sent to applicant, new SP, and old SP (if applicable)





#### Service Substitution

- Submitted by Applicant or Service Provider
- Substituted services or products <u>must</u> have same functionality as the original FRN
- Doesn't violate any contract provisions, or state or local procurement laws
- Doesn't result in an increase in the percentage of ineligible services or functions
- Within the scope of the FCC Form 470, including any RFP, for the original service.
- Submit before the last day to invoice





#### Service Delivery Extension

- Automatic SDE occurs for non-recurring services
  - FCDL, Operational SPIN change or service substitution issued on or after March 1 of the funding year

**For Example**: FY 2012, *FCDL date*: April 12, 2013. Services can be delivered through <u>September 30, 2014</u>.

- Submit SDE request
  - SP was unable to complete installation or deliver services
  - SP was unwilling to complete delivery and installation after USAC withheld payment on a properlysubmitted invoice for more than 60 days after submission of the invoice





- Applicants and service providers have the option of appealing a USAC decision
  - Can be filed by applicant or service provider
  - Must be filed within 60 days of the decision letter (e.g., FCDL, Notification Letter, ADL)
  - Can appeal to USAC or to the FCC
    - Submit directly to the FCC to request an FCC rule waiver (e.g., FCC rule, policy, waive deadline)
  - USAC issues an Administrator's Decision Letter
     (ADL) with the appeal decision (approved, denied)
  - USAC issues a Revised FCDL (RFCDL) when there is a change to the FRN or Block 4
