## FCC Establishes Comment Period for Funding Year 2010 Eligible Services List

On June 2, 2009 the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) released a <u>Public Notice (DA 09-1233)</u> establishing the comment period for the Funding Year 2010 Eligible Services List.

Comments on the draft Eligible Services List, which is attached to the Public Notice, are due to the FCC on or before June 23, 2009. Reply comments are due to the FCC on or before June 30, 2009. For information on filing comments with the FCC, please refer to the Public Notice.

The Public Notice includes a high-level summary of the changes being contemplated. The FCC has also included a red-line version of the Eligible Services List which highlights each of the specific proposed changes.

This proceeding is limited to determining what services are eligible under the FCC's current rules; it is not intended to be a vehicle for changing any eligibility rules.
