### Update on Fall Applicant Training

In preparation for Funding Year 2010, USAC will conduct training for applicants during September and October in a number of locations around the country. This year, USAC plans to offer eight one-day training sessions in the following locations:

- Atlanta, Georgia – September 30, 2009
- Chicago, Illinois – October 2, 2009
- Houston, Texas (not yet posted)
- Los Angeles, California – October 13, 2009
- Newark, New Jersey (not yet posted)
- Orlando, Florida – October 8, 2009
- Portland, Oregon – October 15, 2009
- Washington, DC – September 22, 2009

We hope to be able to post the additional two sessions (Newark and Houston) soon. If you plan to attend training, please sign up for the one training session that best fits your schedule and travel options. Note that the Washington DC session is almost full, and some of the other sessions are filling up fast. Once we reach our space limitation, we will start a waiting list and will only admit registrants on a first-come, first-served basis as cancellations occur.
