Schools and Libraries Cybersecurity Pilot Program Newsletter

Today, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) released a <u>Public Notice</u> announcing the application filing window dates for Part 1 of the Schools and Libraries Cybersecurity Pilot Program (Pilot Program) application. The three-year Pilot Program allocates up to \$200 million in Universal Service Fund (USF) support to offset the cost of cybersecurity services and equipment to protect eligible schools' and libraries' broadband networks and data.

From **September 17, 2024 to November 1, 2024**, schools, libraries, and consortia applicants will be able to access the FCC Form 484 Part 1 in the E-Rate Productivity Center (EPC) and begin completing it. USAC will host a series of technical trainings and office hours sessions to support applicants completing the FCC Form 484 Part 1. Register for a session below.
